# MARCH PROGRAM WITH JUDE CHASE: ACRYLIC POURING WORKSHOP

ACRYLIC POURING WORKSHOP Jude has been an artist since she was in grade school. She started with drawing and over the years moved from watercolor to acrylics and oil. Jude is currently working with fluid acrylics and alcohol inks. She is a member of the Arts Community of Easton and will be exhibiting her works at the ACE Arts Tour that runs from April 1 through May at The Gallery at St. John's as

part of the Artists without Walls exhibit at 330 Ferry St. Easton, PA. Judith is also a member of Artlifting, a non profit organization that helps Artists with disabilities to sell their work. You can find her profile at www.Artlifting.com as Jude Chase.

At the workshop, Jude will explain the dynamics of the fluid acrylic medium and guide the group through the process so each participant can create their own poured acrylic painting. <u>Each student will need to bring the following</u> <u>materials to the meeting:</u>

1 aluminum roasting pan or tray with a lip on it so the paint will stay inside

5 colors of (cheap) acrylic paint, 2 oz each: White, black and 3 other colors. (Warren County ARTS will have some jugs of acrylic paints available for those that do not typically work in this medium).

1 stretched canvas that will fit inside the roasting pan or tray. You could also bring ceramic tiles.

11 plastic 6 oz cups & 2 Liters of water.
