MAY PROGRAM WITH NEELA PUSHPARAJ: WATERCOLOR PAINTING DEMONSTRATION



The May 10th meeting of Warren County ARTS will feature a Watercolor demonstration by Neela Pushparaj. Neela started watercolor lessons in 1987 at age 49, learning the rudiments of watercolor painting from Sarita Anne Cook. Her recommendation to pursue a more formal program led Neela to du'Cret, a non-accredited art school in Plainfield, NJ. Neela spent a whole year going to art school on Wednesdays and the rest of the week working as a Pathologist and she became addicted to painting and watercolors in particular. Neela's favorite way of painting is to add colors to wet or damp paper and allowing shapes to emerge from them by picking them out with negative painting. Neela likes to use a lot of color in her work and describes her florals as a "veritable feast" of color which are semi-abstract to sometimes totally abstract. Neela's landscapes and still life pieces are more restrained. "Painting is an integral part of my life. It is an expression of my joy in everything I see."
