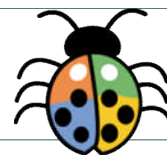
SEPTEMBER PROGRAM WITH ROBERTA ROSE: PHOTO TRANSFER LECTURE



The Sept 13th Warren County ARTs meeting will feature a lecture by photographer- Roberta Rose describing her Photo Transfer technique. Roberta's current work brings photography, collage and painting together, a fusion of elements telling a new story. "These old photographs speak to me. They have been forgotten, discarded and abandoned; their stories crying out to be told. Something in each image calls out, perhaps for some color, some texture, some contrasting image to accompany them. Each finds its own unique combination of light and dark, truth and conjecture. They take on a new substance, a new reality becoming more than they were. They are transformed, reborn."

Funding for this program has been made possible, in part, by the Warren County Cultural and Heritage Commission. The public is welcome to attend, a donation is suggested from visiting non-members.

After all this time we continue to be a close knit group dedicated to our mission to promote the advancement of the arts in Warren County and provide a venue for artists of all disciplines to learn with a variety of monthly programs. We welcome anyone who is an artist, wants to be an artist or appreciates the arts & just enjoys hanging out with artists!. Our meetings are held once a month at the Oxford Municipal Building in Oxford, NJ. Each meeting has an exciting program to stimulate and educate. We offer two members-only shows a year along with opportunities to participate in solo or group exhibits. We also offer special day trips & other events to the membership. WCARTS is a not for profit 501 (c) 3 organization. Funding for our programs is made possible, in part, by a grant from Warren County Cultural & Heritage Commission. We encourage everyone to share their knowledge & experience with the group in the form of a workshop or lecture.

**Upcoming Artist / Exhibition Opportunities**

- **Belvidere Victorian Days Plein Air art event. Saturday Sept 8 & 9th** Seasoned and new artists are welcome to join the Plein Air Art contest and Wet Paint sale at this year's Victorian Days. Artists may register early by purchasing an entry ticket for \$25 to have 2 canvases or papers stamped. \$10 for each additional. Purchasing tickets online, and in advance, will help the organizers prepare for display of the art. In keeping with the tradition of Victorian Days - it is highly recommended that you dress accordingly. Go to Garret Wall Park on Saturday, Sept 8th at 9am or later to have your canvas/paper stamped. Then find the scene or subject anywhere in Belvidere that attracts you. Create your masterpiece and return to the Park on Sunday Sept 9, no later than 1pm for judging. All work will be judged by local accomplished artists. Cash prizes will be awarded. Wet Paint sale begins Sunday 2pm. - **22nd Riverside Festival of the Arts in Easton, PA. SEPT 15 & 16, 2018, 10-5pm** Visit www.Eastonriversidefest.org for application and more information. **Plein Air Art Contest:** Application is available online. Enplein air entry fee is \$40/piece before Sept 1st and \$50/piece after Sept 1st. Your selected canvas(s) or papers must be with you when you sign in at the plein air contest booth. Size can not be larger than 18 x 24". Cash prizes will be awarded. Map will be provided for areas available at festival to paint. Art must be wired to hang by the artist. You must turn in your art and sign out by 5 pm Saturday if art is completed or not to remain in the contest. You may collect on Sunday to continue or start another piece if you choose. You may submit up to two pieces into the contest maximum. Feel free to drop your piece at the booth before 5 pm if you are done for the day on Saturday for the overnight. Return your piece(s) on Sunday for judging by 2 pm no exception. Cash Awards: 1st ~\$1000, 2nd \$300, 3rd \$200.
- **Knowlton Community Days (Sept 29th) - Warren County ARTS Tent.** Warren County ARTS members interested in providing a couple of pieces for display/sale in the booth during Knowlton Community Day- please contact Pamela Dulaff. Pam will be providing her show tent and display walls for the purpose of promoting Warren County ARTs organization to the community. Artists are to bring their artwork directly to the booth Saturday Sept 29th before noon. There is no fee for participation. Member assistance booth sitting, talking up visitors and promoting Warren County ARTS is encouraged! Saturday exhibit hours: 12 - 5pm. We will have the marbleizing paper project for visitors to do.

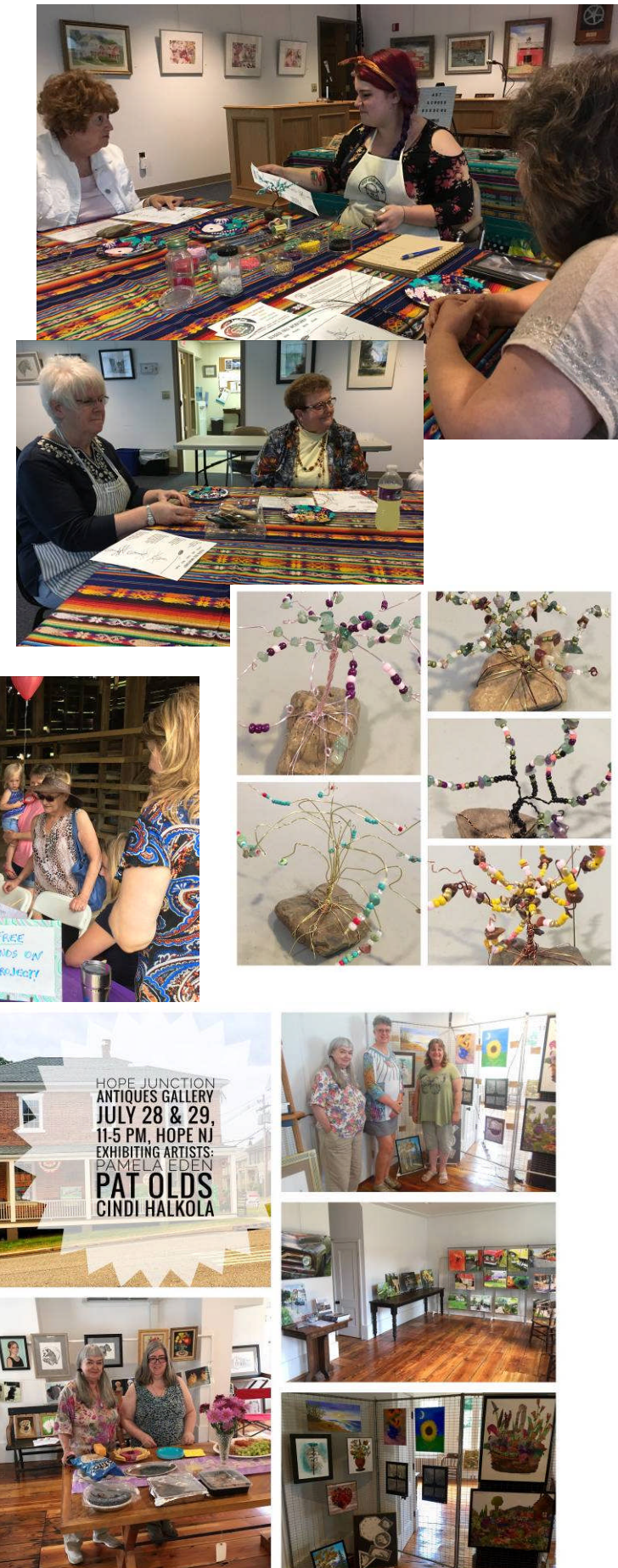
