~ Oct 12th- Hal Murray ~

Wood turning and stone sculpting are reductive processes yielding three-dimensional art. Both topics will be discussed at the WCART October meeting featuring Hal Murray.

Anyone can be shown how to take a piece of wood and, with the use of a lathe, turn a bowl. Taking a fallen tree and turning it into a vessel which, metaphorically represents something well known but would take hundreds of words to describe, is the greater calling. With the aid of numerous pieces Hal will present and describe: how wooden vessels are made on a lathe, aspects of a quality wooden vessel, and present a philosophy that vessels can be metaphors for us, and hence give deeper meaning to the piece.



A demonstration of how soapstone can be cut and sculpted along with some original works will also be displayed on Oct 12th.
