Be Aware- Scams are everywhere!

Several of us, myself included, have received online contacts from scammers/conmenthis year. I posted information on our Facebook page - and want to share the same information here for members who are not on Facebook. Luckily the emails received so far are fairly similar and therefore easy to avoid falling for -when you know what to look out for. Forewarned is Forearmed. The scammer's ultimate objective is to send you a check- which will be bogus. They'll say that the check they've sent you is too much and want you to "take out" the amount due for your artwork and send them a check for the remainder. Here's the scam: Your artwork will be gone, and you'll also be out the cost of shipping, as well as your money for the "remainder" and a bounced check charge to add insult to injury.

Here's an example of one received by member Anju Saran:

"Interested in your Artworks:

My name is Rob smith from Washington DC. I was looking for some artwork online and i found your contact while searching. I will like to purchase some of your work for my wife as a surprise gift for our 20th anniversary. Please kindly send pics and prices of some of your art which are ready for immediate sale within price range \$500- \$5000, i could be flexible with price. So i will hope to hear a lot more about any available piece in your inventory ready for immediate sale.
