\$35 for single membership, \$60 for family memberships ("family" all living at same address), \$30 for Seniors 75+, \$20 for students 18+ with school ID.

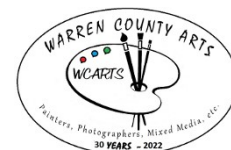

November Program Highlight— Better Smartphone Photography with Scott Piccotti

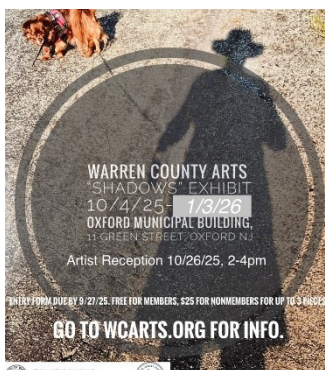

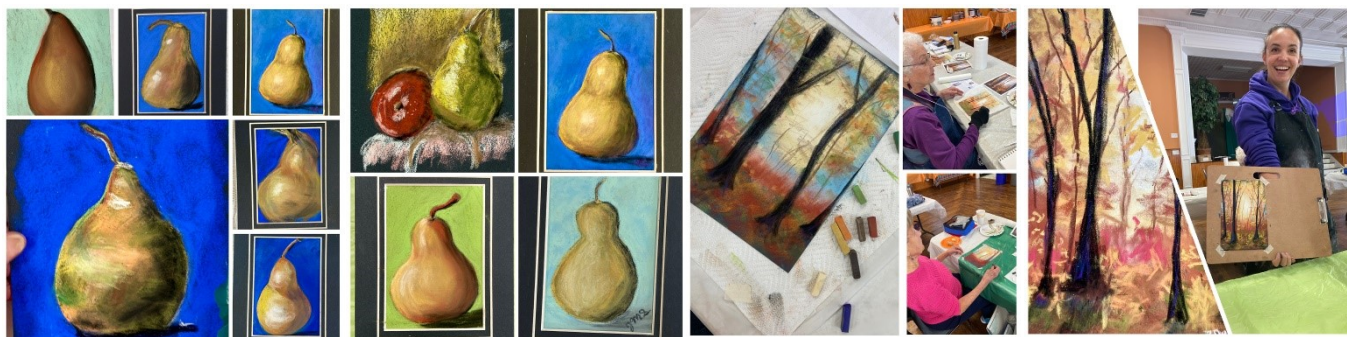
