

January Highlight: Artist talk about Quilting & Sashiko with Claire Rohloff

Join Warren County ARTS for an artist talk and hands on workshop on Saturday, January 10th, 1-3pm in the Oxford Municipal Building with Claire Rohloff who will present a



basic history of quilting and then guide us through an exercise to create a coaster using sashiko needlework. Class size limited to 20 participants and all materials will be provided. Free for members, \$25 for non-members to receive materials & participate in the workshop. Below is a sample of what the stitching looks like. Sashiko is an ancient



Japanese type of quilting using a running stitch in repetitive geometric patters. Claire has a sashiko quilt on display as part of her Quilt Exhibit hanging in the Municipal Building (1/3/26—2/28/26). Be sure to take time to checkout all her beautiful quilts before you leave the meeting!

The Reception for Claire's Quilt Exhibit is Sunday, Jan 25th, 2-4pm.
